- **DESCRIPTION:** The existing synthetic turf field is nearing the end of its life expectancy. The subgrade is starting to experience shallow depressions necessitating more intense and costly maintenance in order to keep the field playable and safe.

The project includes removal of the existing synthetic turf field, installation of under field drainage, reestablishment of the subgrade, and installation of a new synthetic turf field.

- **CHALLENGES:** In order to achieve the school's requirement that the field be back online the first week of August when football practice starts, the duration of design process has been compressed to allow as much time as possible to navigate the District's unpredictable permit process.
